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## ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY

On 26th July 1962, Jawaharlal Nehru laid the foundation stone of Nehru Gram Bharati with a vision to establish an institution of higher learning dedicated to rural transformation and nation-building.

Emerging as one of the pioneering rural universities in Uttar Pradesh, Nehru Gram Bharati is among the few higher education institutions in India situated in a rural setting. The University was declared a "Deemed to be University" under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, by the Ministry of Education (formerly the Ministry of Human Resource Development) vide Notification No. F.9-42/2005-43(A) dated 27th June

2008 and No. 12-25/2023-U.3(A) dated 24th November 2023.

Pandit Nehru believed that the development of India's hinterland depended upon education, scientific temper, and social participation. His vision of establishing institutions of higher learning in rural areas was realized in 2008 by Sri J. N. Misra, an eminent bureaucrat, social thinker, and philanthropist. Inspired by the ideals of Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru, and committed to empowering rural communities through quality education, he transformed this dream into reality by establishing Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj.

In alignment with the National Education Policy 2020, the University has restructured its academic framework from the 2023–24 academic session to promote holistic, flexible, and multidisciplinary education. It has adopted a comprehensive curriculum structure incorporating Academic Bank of Credits (ABC) provisions and multiple entry–exit options. The University integrates skill-based, vocational, and value-added courses to enhance employability and entrepreneurial competencies. It actively promotes research, innovation, and incubation through strengthened industry linkages and collaborations. Emphasis is placed on experiential learning, internships, community engagement, and field-based projects. # About the Founder



Shri. J. N. Misra was born on 1st October 1938 in Allahabad (now Prayagraj), a city renowned for its rich spiritual heritage and the world-famous Kumbh Mela. Raised in a remote rural village during a period of intense political change and social transformation, he grew up witnessing India's emergence from more than two centuries of British colonial rule. Although independence had been achieved, the world's largest democracy faced numerous challenges, and the nation-building process demanded a strong emphasis on education-particularly for rural youth.

This atmosphere of political awakening deeply influenced young J.N. Misra. Inspired by visionary leaders such as Mahatma Gandhi and Jawaharlal Nehru, he cultivated a strong commitment to learning and public service. Beginning his education in a modest rural school with a thatched roof, he overcame financial hardships through perseverance and hard work. Supporting his family while pursuing academic excellence, he eventually earned admission to the prestigious University of Allahabad. From that point onward, his aspirations continued to grow.

In 1963, he joined the State Civil Services and, in 1973, was promoted to Indian Administrative Services (IAS) to serve the Government of India at the Central level in the Ministry of Shipping, Transport and Railways. During this period, under the guidance of Kamla Pati Tripathi, a distinguished statesman and social reformer, he achieved remarkable excellence in public service.

His unwavering commitment to Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru's vision of establishing institutions of higher learning in rural India was realized with the establishment of Nehru Gram Bharati in 2008. He envisioned an educational institution focussed on affordability, accessibility, and employability, particularly catering to students from rural and tribal communities.

# Admission Policy



1. To ensure admission of students with academic competence and potentialities of high quality so that its alumni may be able to play their role in the process of nation building and social change in a meaningful manner.
2. To ensure that adequate number of students from the under-privileged and socially handicapped sections of our society are admitted to the University.
3. The Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), is open to all persons irrespective of gender, caste, creed, religion, race or class, and it shall not be lawful for the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), to adopt or impose on any person, any test whatsoever of religious belief or profession in order to entitle him/her to be admitted as a student in the NGB (DU) or to graduate there at or to enjoy or exercise any privilege.
4. The NGB shall maintain an all-India character and high standards of teaching and research and shall provide merit-based admission in a fair and transparent manner. The merit of a student will be determined through a Common National level entrance examination conducted offline/online by the NGB (DU) either individually or by any other Central/State agency.
5. Admission in the Nehru Gram Bharati shall be open to Indian citizens, Non-Resident Indians, and persons of Indian origin. However, the NGB (DU) shall also admit foreign students as per the Government of India and State Government guidelines. Provided that titles, eligibility criteria and duration of Degree programs shall be strictly as per the specifications of degrees prescribed in UGC Regulations. Admissions will be open to NHEQF 4.5, 5.0 & 5.5 Level in NEP-2020 implemented Programmes having multiple entry and exit provisions. Provided further that equivalence for entry level eligibility shall be decided as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU) for foreign students. Provided further that no students passing eligibility examination from unrecognized Board or unrecognized University/Deemed to be University shall be allowed admission or grant of degree by the Deemed to be University.

6. For NRI/Foreign students, admission shall be made on merit of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations as per provisions of regulatory bodies, as may be applicable.
7. Initially student shall be provisionally admitted and after due verification of all relevant eligibility documents with their original documents they shall be finally admitted and thereafter enrolment number for a student shall be generated.
8. All the Admissions related documents viz admission forms, transfer/migration certificates, compiled data of admissions etc. shall be collected in the Admission Cell (in both physical and digital formats) and maintained as per the University norms. The Admission Cell shall provide the information to all concerned departments on a regular basis. All transfer/Migration Certificates shall be duly submitted within 30 days from the admission.
9. In cases, where the admissions are to be given by an agency determined by State or Central Government, the Deemed to be University shall follow the norms and procedure as prescribed by them.
10. The NGB (DU) wherever necessary, may also consider score/merit in an entrance test conducted by any other State level/ National level agency appointed by the relevant government for admissions. (Eg. CUET UG/PG).
11. The admission and enrolment in various program/programs of the various Departments/Faculties of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) including reservation of seats shall be in accordance with the procedure and policy laid down in the ordinance of the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), policies of Government of India, State Government, and UGC norms as applicable to unaided deemed to be universities.
12. End Semester Examination fees for all programmes shall be applicable as per NGB (DU) norms.
13. **Fee Refund Policy** : Request/application of admitted students seeking cancellation of admission and refund of the fee will be entertained as per current UGC Fee Refund Policy.
14. Once a student has completed the admission process, **any request for modification of admission details will be considered only within one month from the date of admission.** Such requests must be submitted in writing, along with valid supporting documents, to the concerned office for approval. After the completion of the stipulated one-month period, no requests for changes or corrections in admission records shall be entertained under any circumstances. Students are therefore advised to carefully verify all information at the time of admission to avoid any inconvenience later.



## LATERAL ENTRY

Lateral entry into undergraduate courses under NEP 2020 allows students to join a program at a later stage, leveraging credits earned earlier.

### Eligibility-

- **Entry at level 5 (2nd Year):** Students who have attained Under Graduate Certificate with minimum 44 credits (40 +4 credits of internship) can apply for lateral entry in the second year (level 5).
- **Entry at level 5.5 (Third Year):** Students who have attained Under Graduate Diploma with minimum 84 credits (80 +4 credits of internship) can apply for lateral entry in the third year (level 5.5).

Credits earned earlier will be considered for transfer through the Academic Bank of Credits (ABC).

## Guideline for Opting Courses

**Major Courses:** Students must choose any **two major courses from Pool A** (Pool of major subjects from faculty of Arts and Science) according to his/her interest. The first major (Major 1) course will be considered as B.A./B.Sc. Hons. with research and the second subject will be the other major course (Major 2). The two major courses will continue upto the third year or VI<sup>th</sup> semester.

There are programmes with single major/core subject such as **B.A./B.A. (Honours)/ B.A. (Honours with Research) in Single Core Discipline:** Journalism & Mass Communication, **B.Com./B.Com. (Honours)/ B.Com. (Honours with Research) in Single Core Discipline:** Commerce, **B.B.A./B.B.A. (Honours)/ B.B.A. (Honours with Research) with Single Core Discipline:** Business Administration [ As per AICTE Curricula] and **B.C.A./B.C.A. (Honours)/ B.C.A. (Honours with Research) with Single Core Discipline:** Computer Application [ As per AICTE Curricula].

One Major elective course is to be chosen in semesters V, VI, and VIII. Two major elective courses are to be chosen in semester VII.

**Minor Courses:** There are 20 subjects offering minor courses for each semester. Apart from choosing two major courses or choosing a single core programme, the students must choose **one minor course as well from Pool B**. The minor course will continue upto VII<sup>th</sup> semester. The course chosen as minor should be different from the subject chosen as major course. For example, if a student has chosen English as Major 1 and Geography as Major 2, then he/she must choose minor course from the list of courses of subjects except that of English and Geography. He/she may continue the courses available for the same minor subject from semester I to VII or may change it in the consecutive years/semesters (uptill 4<sup>th</sup> year/VII<sup>th</sup> semester).

**Skill Enhancement Courses (SEC):** There are 23 courses in Pool C for skill enhancement. The students must opt for only one skill enhancement course in the first year. Paper I of the opted SEC will be taught in semester I and paper 2 of the same course will be taught in semester II. In the second year (semester III and IV), the students must opt any other SEC from Pool C as per their interest.

**Value-Added Courses (VAC):** Value added courses are compulsory courses. The courses of value addition are fixed for each semester (semester I to VI). Please refer to Pool D for value added course.

**Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses (AECC):** Ability Enhancement Compulsory Courses are also compulsory courses. The AECC are fixed for each semester (semester I to V). Please refer to AECC table.

**Indian Knowledge System (IKS):** An introductory paper will be taught to all students (opting for single core or multi core) in the I<sup>st</sup> semester. Applied IKS will be taught in semester III<sup>rd</sup> and V<sup>th</sup>. Applied IKS is a course that refers to the integration of traditional Indian Knowledge Systems with modern thoughts and concepts related to the opted Major 1.

**Summer Internship/Apprenticeship** is a key aspect of the new UG Programme. It is induction of students into actual work situations. All students will also undergo Internships/Apprenticeships in a firm, industry, or organization or Training in labs with Faculty and Researchers in their own or other HEIs/Research institutions **during the summer term or in the VI<sup>th</sup> Semester**. Students can opt for it depending on their interest or choose any summer internship course related to the SEC chosen earlier.

**Research Project/Dissertation:** Students choosing a 4-Year Bachelor's degree (Honours with Research) are required to take up research projects under the guidance of a faculty member. The students are expected to complete the Research Project in the VIII<sup>th</sup> semester. The research outcomes of their project work may be published in peer-reviewed journals or may be presented in conferences /seminars or may be patented.

## UNIVERSITY FREESHIPS & SCHOLARSHIPS:

Determination of eligibility norms for Free-ship and Fee Rebates for all students (incl. Sports category):

Coverage:

- No. of Seats to be considered is 02% to the total number of seats (separately for UG and PG) for each category.
- Only applicable on Tuition Fee.
- This policy would be applicable for only the general Courses; it will not apply to Professional Courses & the Ph.D. Programme.
- Any student beneficiary, if found eligible, would only be entitled to anyone of the two — Freeships OR Fee Rebate/Financial assistance (to be read with Clause B of this document)

**(a) Type of Freeships—** Merit cum means 75% marks in qualifying examinations. Should belong to the rural areas (as notified) plus Antyodaya Card holder. 100% of the tuition fees waiver

**Note: Subject to Review for continuation.**

**(b) Cases of Wards (of employees)** Existing employee (with a regular appointment, NOT applicable for Adhoc/Temporary/Job Work employees) Applicable to only son/daughter, NOT any other relatives. In case the employee has passed away while being in regular employment, with under as wards, such wards would be considered eligible under this category. Freeship of 50% will be admissible.

**(c) Siblings**

- 02 Siblings studying in NGB(DU) at any given point (in general courses only would be eligible for 50% freeship for the second/or latter of the two siblings.
- In case 03 siblings are studying in the University they would be eligible for a 100% freeship of 01 student (the third/last of the siblings) as mentioned above.

**(d) Sports:** All Sports cases will be dealt by a notified Sports Selection Board (SSB) of the University, with the quorum decision, compulsorily with the endorsement of an external sports person of repute. For Team events: Evidence of being part of the 1st and/or 2nd position holder final playing team is essential.

**For individual events:** Appropriate Evidence required. Any event sanctioned/supported by IOC/National Federations/State Federations/ Associations/ Para Games Committee/AIU/Khelo India/ etc. Would be considered for the following:

**(i) International participation —** 100% freeship

**(ii) National level Medal/Certificate —** Gold/Silver/Bronze and /or 1st /2nd and 3rd place only - 100% Freeship

**(iii) State level Medal/ Certificate —** Gold/Silver and / or 1st /2nd only — 100% Freeship.

**Note:** In case a candidate is in a Professional Course/PhD Programme then they may make a represent their case to the Competent Authority for consideration.

**(e) Divyangjan:** 50% Freeship for candidates with 40% and above disability/ blindness/ hearing impaired — as certified by the CMO.

**(f) Any other categories**

**(i) Wards of Ex-Servicemen :** 50% Freeship with the following conditions only 75% marks in qualifying examinations. Should belong to the rural areas (as notified).

**(ii) Members of any special Community** residing in the 50 km radius of the University: 50% Freeship — Evidenced by the certificate from the DM.

**(iii) Wards of Alumni—** 50% Freeship

**(iv) Candidates having lost both parents during Covid 19 Pandemic —** 50% Freeship (on certification from the DM)

**(v) Third Gender —** 50% Freeship — evidence with a certificate from Competent Authority.

**(vi) Candidates from the North East of India, & UTs:** 50% Freeship.

- A.** Fee rebate/financial assistance of any kind would be admissible only on the following conditions:
- Can only be granted by the Chancellor, Vice Chancellor, Pro-Vice Chancellor and/or on the recommendations of the Executive Council, only on special cases.
  - Would be applicable only once, on sanction.
- B.** Procedure for the same.
- All the above cases would be routed through the office of the Dean (Student Welfare) to the Competent Authority.
  - Fee Payment methods: Online and Offline both.



- 1- After submission of Programme Fee and verification of eligibility original Documents, the student with his/her Fee Receipt has to visit the concerned department for Departmental Registration & is mandatory for all students. The Course Form is to be approved from HOD and Admission Cell Copy is to be deposited back to Admission Cell.
- 2- The Candidates who have taken provisional admission through online payment of programme fee by himself/herself through the HEI's website. He/She will have to report for verification of original documents to confirm their admissions. He/she will also have to complete departmental procedures like departmental registration and approval of Course Form from HODs and submission of the same to the Admission Cell within seven days from the date of payment of programme Fee.
- 3- For Students Identity Card, the student shall have to fill the prescribed form (Provided by Admission Cell) and submit it to the Proctor's Office located in every campus of the University.
- 4- For Library Card, the student shall have to fill the Library Card Form (Provided by Admission Cell) and get it made from the Central Library located at Shashi Campus.
- 5- The student should ensure that his/her APAAR ID is generated and is shared in the Application Form. In case, the APAAR ID is still not generated, he/she will have to visit EDP cell (Located on 1st Floor, Central Library Building in Shashi Campus) of the University and get it generated without any delay.
- 6- 75% Attendance is mandatory for eligibility for appearing in the examinations as well as for getting scholarships.
- 7- In case of any grievance from students, they are advised to write a complaint and drop it in the nearby Complaint box or they may submit their grievance on the Grievance Redressal Portal tab (<https://ngbv.ac.in/grievance/>) available on Home Page of HEI's website ([www.ngbv.ac.in](http://www.ngbv.ac.in)).
- 8- No Claim will be entertained for fee submission other than the student should always deposit/submit their Fee only through University's fee counters available inside the campus or the facility available on the website ([www.ngbv.ac.in](http://www.ngbv.ac.in)) for fee submission. The students should collect their Fee Receipts immediately after fee submission from University Fee Counter or should download the Fee Receipt from the website.

# Code of Conduct for Students

## छात्रों के लिये आचार संहिता

- छात्रों का अपने परिचय पत्र के साथ ही विश्वविद्यालय में प्रवेश करना अनिवार्य है।
- छात्रों को कक्षा के साथ-साथ विश्वविद्यालय परिसर के अंदर भी पूर्ण अनुशासन बनाए रखना चाहिए।
- छात्रों को कक्षाओं में समय का पाबंद होना चाहिए तथा अपना कार्य पूर्ण श्रद्धा से करना।
