

Terms & Conditions

Contest Rules:

1. The NGBU Impulse Quiz (**put final contest name here**) is being organized by Nehru Gram Bharati deemed University
2. Impulse Quiz is an online contest that comprises 2 stages: Level 1 & Level 2
3. Only students who have registered for the programme are eligible to participate in the contest. If any student participates in the contest without having registered her/his name with the organizers prior to participating, through the mechanism provided for the process, such participation will be regarded as null and void, and the participant will not be eligible for any prize whatsoever, regardless of having won any.
4. The Impulse Quiz contest and subsidiary parts are open only to Indian citizens residing within the geographical territory of India only.
5. Entry is through online registrations only. If you are a student who wishes to participate, you will need to register yourself online. Once you register online you will receive the credentials for participation.
6. Participation in the contest will be on individual basis. Group participation and gameplay is not allowed. In case any such group attempt is made and discovered, the entry of all such participants that have collaborated will be rendered null and void and they shall not be eligible for any prizes whatsoever.
7. Only students at Intermediate level and Undergraduate level are eligible to participate in the contest.
8. The registered students shall be first eligible to participate in the Level 1 (ONE) Online Test, where each student will get 15 minutes to attempt 15 questions in an MCQ (Multiple Choice Question) format.
9. In the Level 1 Online Test, the total score of the participant shall be considered as the first filter for further qualification to the Level 2 Online Test, and the total time taken as the second filter for the same.
10. Students can take the online tests from any location, using any device.
11. Students will be allowed a maximum of 3 attempts for the Level 1 Online Test and the best of the 3 scores will be taken into consideration for qualifying for the next level.
12. The organizers shall facilitate the online test and evaluate the entries. The system shall take into account the score obtained by the student as well as the time taken by each student, to rank students from each school in a merit list.
13. The merit list with scores of all participating students will be uploaded to the NGB website at the appropriate location and can be inspected by any participant.
14. The list of qualifying students for the Level 2 Online Test shall comprise the top 10% participants on the basis of their performance in the Level 1 Online Test.
15. As mentioned earlier, the absolute score shall be the first filter, and the total time taken for the best scoring test attempt shall be taken as the second filter.
16. The qualifying students shall then be eligible to participate in the Level 2 (TWO) Online Test, where each student will get 15 minutes to attempt 15 questions in an MCQ (Multiple Choice Question) format.
17. In the Level 2 Online Test, the total score of the participant shall be considered as the first filter for final placing, and the total time taken as the second filter for the same.
18. Students can take the online tests from any location, using any device.
19. Students will be allowed a maximum of 2 attempts for the Level 2 Online Test and the best of the 2 scores will be taken into consideration for qualifying for the next level.

20. The organizers shall facilitate the online test and evaluate the entries. The system shall take into account the score obtained by the student as well as the time taken by each student, to rank students from each school in a merit list.
21. The merit list with scores of all playing students will be uploaded to the NGB website at the appropriate location and can be inspected by any participant.
22. Prize winners will be notified through email and message wherever and whatever mode is most efficacious.

Gratification:

1. All participants will receive a digital Certificate of Participation, which they can download and print for their records.
2. The first 2020 registered participants will be eligible for the Early Bird Discount Voucher worth 10% of the fees to the course they take admission for at NGB. These vouchers cannot be redeemed or exchanged for cash. Each voucher may be used only once.
3. Meritorious participants, who qualify for Level 2 will be awarded certificates of excellence.
4. The Grand Prize Winner shall get a Scholarship as per the following: (insert grand prize scholarship details here).

8. In case a prize winner does not take admission to the NGB deemed University, such participant agrees that she/he forfeits any and all rights to the prize and shall not receive any remuneration in lieu thereof.

General Rules:

1. Any attempt to influence NGB or use of unfair means will result in automatic disqualification from the contest.
2. The decision of the organisers shall be final, and no claims shall be entertained whatsoever.
3. Submission of entry means that the participant student agrees to abide by the rules of the contest.
4. All submitted entries and associated data shall become the property of NGB, and may be used for promotion of the contest.
5. Participants understand and agree to the fact that the prizes are scholarships for studying at Nehru Gram Bharti deemed University, and shall not, and will not be exchanged/redeemed/or otherwise converted into cash in and under any circumstances. The prizes are only for the students who have won them, and cannot and will not be transferred to any other person under any circumstances.
6. The participants understand and agree that the contests contained within Impulse Quiz 2020 are sponsored activities and the participation is voluntary.
7. The participants understand that the organisers may alter or change the format of Impulse Quiz 2020, as well as the content of the applicable rules in relation to the programme and that the organisers retain the right to make any such changes/amendments to the format and/or rules of the contest that they may deem necessary or fit, in the interest of the final benefit of the contest.

8. The participants agree to abide by all the rules and regulations and to co-operate in every manner and to follow instructions of the organisers.
9. The participants understand that all the rights including but not limited to the intellectual property rights, copyrights and all other allied, ancillary and subsidiary rights in any and all media like photographs, tapes, films and audio/video recordings of the events and activities that comprise the Impulse Quiz 2020, promotional activity and/or otherwise that may form part of or be allied to the Impulse Quiz 2020 whether now known or subsequently invented shall vest with the organisers and/or their affiliates absolutely for perpetuity, throughout the world. Participants grant the organisers a royalty-free, worldwide, perpetual, non-exclusive license to display, distribute, reproduce and to create derivative works of all photographs, tapes, movies and recordings of the participants related to the programme, promotional activity and/or otherwise in and to the programme concerning the participants related to the programme, in whole or in part, in any media now existing or subsequently developed, for any educational, promotional, publicity, exhibition, archival, and any other standard purposes.
10. It is also understood and agreed to by the participants that the organisers shall have the right to use all materials produced in/during or for the Impulse Quiz 2020 and/or any footages relating to the program by any and all means throughout the world and shall also have the right to syndicate, license to third party, edit, cut, translate, dub, package or alter any footages relating to the participation of the students as stated herein, and to combine them with other material for any purposes.
11. The participants declare that they release the organisers, their directors, employees, contractors and agents/assigns from and against any actions, claims and/or demands that they may have now or in the future in relation to Impulse Quiz 2020. Contestants also waive their right to file either directly themselves or through their family / friends / associates / representatives, any applications, criminal and/or civil proceedings in any court or forum in India and/or any other jurisdiction, against the organisers to claim any damages or reliefs.
12. The participants agree to indemnify and agree to keep the organisers, their employees, or any other person directly or indirectly connected to NGB deemed University indemnified against any claim, loss, damages and liability arising as a result of their participation in any photo-shoots, workshops/ assignments, auditions and/or otherwise.
13. The organisers reserve the right to halt, postpone, and/or cancel any part of the Impulse Quiz 2020 as they may see fit. The organisers also reserve the right to change all or any part of terms & conditions that are applicable, without giving prior intimation of any kind and being liable for any consequential losses/damages.
14. Nothing herein amounts to a commitment or representation by the organisers to conduct further or other quizzes/ contests.
15. Comments of winners or materials sent to the organisers including feedback and other communications of any kind shall be deemed to be non-confidential. The organisers are free to reproduce, distribute and publicly display such feedback and programme entries without limitations or obligation of any kind. The organisers are also free to use any ideas, concepts, know-how or techniques contained in such feedback for any purpose. The organisers reserve the right to analyze and summarize data that they collect and also reserve the right to publish, distribute, share summaries of the data collected with sponsors or other business partners without limitations or obligations of any kind.
16. The decision of the organisers and/or their respective representatives, employees, directors, officers or agents with respect to the programme, any matter related thereto including the choice of questions or the manner of choosing of winners will be final and binding on all participants and no questions, correspondence, enquiries, etc. on the manner of conduct of the programme from any party whatsoever will be entertained.
17. In case of any dispute in relation to participation in the programme, the organisers and the participant(s) will try to resolve such dispute by negotiations in an amicable manner. This Agreement shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of India. It is

understood that the Courts of Allahabad shall have exclusive jurisdiction with respect to any dispute arising in connection with your participation in the programme.

18. The interpretation and implementation of the Terms and Conditions shall be at the sole discretion of the organisers. Their decisions shall be final and binding, and not subject to challenge or appeal.

The participation of the students in the programme shall mean that they acknowledge that they have carefully read and understood the Terms and Conditions of the programme and that they agree to adhere to and comply with the foregoing Terms and Conditions (as they now stand or as they may be changed or amended hereafter).
