Memorandum of Understanding

Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

This Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) is entered into on this 1st day of May, 2025 hereinafter called the "Effective Date".

By and among

AIC STPINEXT INITIATIVES, a section 8 company incorporated under Companies Act, 2013 by STPI (Software Technology Park of India) having registered office at 1st Floor, Plate-B, Office Block 1, East Kidwai Nagar, New Delhi-110 023 and branch office at STPI Lucknow hereinafter referred to as the "**First Party**" or "**STPINEXT**", which expression shall unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, mean and include its successors and assigns of the First Party.

And

Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed To Be University), Prayagraj, Uttar Pradesh (hereinafter referred to as "NGB(DU)"), occupies an esteemed place among the rural universities of India for over decades now. Established on 27th June 2008, under Section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956 is one of the promising institutes in the State of Uttar Pradesh hereinafter referred to as the "**Second Party**". The campus has emerged as a prominent establishment of professional, technical

education and traditional education for meeting the aspirations of youth from rural as well as urban areas.

1. SCOPE OF MOU

The Parties hereby express their willingness to enter into this Memorandum of Understanding to facilitate and accelerate innovation in technology, Incubator and commercialization thereof, and work towards promoting the growth of the sector by creating necessary eco-system for the Technology Incubator. This document is enabling and guiding tool for all the participants to achieve the common goal of contributing to the development of state of art and the nation at large by pursuing research and entrepreneurial activities and task set out under this MoU.

NOW THEREFORE, as duly communicated and agreed by and between the parties the conditions of this MOU is as follows:

1.1. Role and Responsibilities of STPINEXT:

- 1.1.1. Try to make a provision for providing platform for students with hands-on training in emerging technologies such as Artificial Intelligence, Machine Learning, Data Science, Cyber security, and other IT/ITES fields.
- 1.1.2. To assist NGB (DU) in organizing workshops, seminars, and guest lectures conducted by industry experts and professionals associated with STPINEXT/STPI.
- 1.1.3. To promote entrepreneurship among NGB(DU) students by providing incubation support through STPI's incubation centers and startup initiatives.
- 1.1.4. To encourage and support students in developing innovative tech-based solutions and business ideas, with guidance on commercialization and funding.
- 1.1.5. To provide mentorship opportunities for aspiring entrepreneurs, enabling them to turn their ideas into successful ventures as per policy of STPI/STPINEXT.
- 1.1.6. To allow students to access advanced IT infrastructure, including high-speed internet, modern computing labs, and cloud computing facilities on charge basis as per prevailing tariff.
- 1.1.7. Try to facilitate collaboration with industry partners and IT companies through STPINEXT/STPI's networking platforms, giving students exposure to real-world projects and business challenges.
- 1.1.8. Endeavour to strengthen the connection between NGB(DU) and the IT/ITES industry, providing a pathway for students to engage in internships, live projects, and job placements.
- 1.1.9. To involve NGB(DU) in STPI/STPINEXT industry-related events, such as hackathons, coding competitions, and innovation challenges, encouraging student participation

1.1.10. All the aforementioned activities shall be undertaken in accordance with the existing rules and regulations prevalent at STPI/STPINEXT.

1.2. Role and Responsibilities of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed To Be University) (NGB(DU)):

- 1.2.1. NGB(DU) would host the 'Innovation & Incubation Centre' and provide built up space and other facilities related to entrepreneurial Incubator.
- 1.2.2. Invite key experts from the industry to conduct hands on training workshops and other relevant programs in the 'Innovation & Incubation Centre' and lectures by experts for start-ups on regular basis.
- 1.2.3. Supporting the start-ups during the incubation phases.
- 1.2.4. NGB(DU) will share auditorium common meetings area for conducting technology and other relevant sessions as and when required.
- 1.2.5. NGB(DU) shall support promotional events/programmes to start-ups for market access and visibility of their products/solutions.

2. DURATION, TERMINATION AND AMENDMENT:

Duration: This MoU shall remain in force for Five (5) years from the date of the last signature. The Parties may mutually agree to review/extend the MoU after the period of validity"

Extension and Renewal: The Parties may extend or renew this MoU by agreement, confirmed in a written amendment signed by each Party's authorized signatory.

Amendment: No amendment of the terms of this MoU will be effective unless made in written and signed by each Party's authorized signatory"

3. GENERAL MATTERS:

Except in promoting the activities proposed above both parties may require written permission from each other for use of the name & logo of the other party. The Parties will seek permission from one another by submitting the proposed use, at least two months ahead of any deadline. Each Party shall bear its own costs and expenses incurred in relation to the negotiation and execution of this MoU.

4. CONFIDENTIALITY:

In the course of the activities under this MoU it may be necessary for the Parties to disclose confidential Information. Unless otherwise expressly permitted in this agreement, any and all information, correspondence, financial statements, records, data, or information that is competitively sensitive and not generally known to the public, including formulations.

analysis, inventions, improvements and activities of the disclosing Party, disclosed by one Party to the other Party of this MoU, and other documents transmitted or communicated by either Party to the other party that is marked as confidential or proprietary for the purposes of this agreement ("Confidential Information") shall be received and treated in confidence, and shall not be used by the receiving Party or disclosed by the receiving Party without the prior written consent of the disclosing Party, which consent shall not be unreasonably withheld or delayed. These restrictions on use or disclosure of information do not extend to any item of information which (a) is publically known at the time of the disclosure, (b) is lawfully received by the receiving Party from a third party which does not have a confidential relationship to the disclosing Party, (c) the receiving Party can demonstrate was in its possession or known by it before its receipt from the disclosing Party, or (d) the receiving Party is required by law to disclose to government authorities (including courts). Unless otherwise required under a subsequent binding agreement, each receiving Party shall, at the expiry or termination of this agreement, return to the disclosing Party any and all documents provided by the disclosing Party setting out as Confidential Information.

5. NOTICES:

The Parties must give all notices under this MoU in writing. All communications must be sent to the addresses set forth below or to such other address designated by the Parties by written notice. Notices are effective upon receipt"

6. EXIT CLAUSES:


Each party will have the option to exit from MoU, by serving a notice of three months to the other parties to the MoU, with or without assigning any reason thereof.


7. INDEMNIFICATION:

All Parties agree to defend, indemnify and hold other Parties, its officers, employees and agents harmless from and against any and all liability, loss, expense, attorneys' fees, or claims for injury or damages arising out of the activities under this MoU, but only in proportion to and to the extent such liability, loss, expense, attorneys' fees, or claims for injury or damages are caused by or result from the negligent or intentional acts or omissions of the Party.

8. NON-BINDING NATURE:

This MoU is not intended to and does not give any person who is not a Party to it any rights to enforce any of its provisions. Nothing in this MoU will be construed as creating a binding legal relationship between the Parties" This MoU is a broad statement of intent which sets forth the general basis upon which the Parties wish to proceed. No legal liability will arise in respect of any subject matter here of unless a subsequent binding agreement is negotiated, approved, executed and delivered by the Parties to this MoU.

9. GOVERNING LAW, JURISDICTION & ARBITRATION:

This MoU shall be construed, interpreted and enforced in accordance with Laws of India.

In case of any differences, the parties, shall make all efforts to settle the disputes amicably through mutual discussion and negotiation, failing which, dispute(s) shall be referred to a sole Arbitrator appointed by the Parties, as per provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. Language of Arbitration shall be English, and place of Arbitration shall be Prayagraj, India.

Subject to the Arbitration Clause, the High Court at Prayagraj shall have exclusive jurisdiction in respect of any and all matters pertaining to this MoU.

10. FORCE MAJEURE:

None of the parties shall be considered to be in default or breach if prevented by circumstances beyond control as per the standard conditions of Force Majeure.

Authorized Signatories: Each Party represents that the individuals signing this MoU have the authority to sign on its behalf in the capacity indicated.
