

II) FEEDBACK/ outcome of the Webinar

- ❖ Taken lead from the Indian System of Medicine (ISM) and from our previous findings; the present proposal is an effort to repurposing the individual drug candidate which already had proven efficacy on various disorders to make a novel formulation against prevention and management of COVID-19.




