Deliberations:

The session opened with presentation by Director-IQAC on the NIRF rankings – its character; importance; and its requirements.

The session moved to a true roundtable form with the Dean (Academics) taking lead with focus on improving the teaching learning process. He also stressed on the curriculum updation.

Dean (Arts) focused on the character of NEP 2020 and talked about changes in the last 4 yrs in the University.

Dean (Science) focused his talk on the research output; and the use of impact factor in evaluation of the research output. He also highlighted the reality of the functioning of the various DRCs in campus.

Dean (Commerce) talked about the updation of his syllabus & the adequacy of his curriculum.

Dean (Law) talked about the initiatives that he wants to carryout in law dept with the aim of aiding the NIRF score. The idea of a dance club was turned down, however the clubs form was accepted.

Dean (Mgt) talked about the infrastructural shortcomings and the impact it has on the admissions.



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Dean (SW) talked her requirements for the DSW 's Office, and how it was affecting the overall performance.

Convener-RAC talked about the 'to and fro movement of the faculty members' under the NEP2020 (i.e retaining/ constant relearning) . He also shared his experience of his Ministry days on how the IPR issues were handled.

Mr Namit Mishra raised the issue of the execution of the Internship scheme in the University, and how it can contribute to the perceptual scores.

Adv. to Chancellor raised the issues of meeting the regulatory requirements, and the need to have quality teaching. He also raised the issue of outreach impacts and how it impacts the score under the NIRF.

ProVC Sir highlighted the importance of 'tenure' in the rankings, and how it can impact the image of an Instt. He also highlighted the 'societal impact of research' aspects with current examples from MNIT...where PhD reserachhad shown a realworld applications. He encouraged the teachers to embrace quality – in both their personal works and also in their supervision.

VC Sir highlighted the importance of 'rigour' in the evaluation of PhD Research – in all stages. He further highlighted the issue of curriculum redesign and the delivery, esp. in professional programmes. His emphasis was on the immediate and increased use of bloom's taxonomy in the end-semester question papers in this HEI.

Recommendations:

1. A session on the "Awareness of the Impact Factor" for all domains - to be conducted by Director(Res. Center) under the banner of IQAC
2. Greater Scrutiny in the DRCs on synopsis preparations, and approval.
3. The Exams dept to be asked to ensure that the model Bloom's Taxonomy document be sent to all external/internal question paper setters in the docket.
4. The IQAC was mandated to continue the holding of similar sessions.
