

## Glimpses of Prayagraj

Situated on the confluence of holy rivers- Ganga, Yamuna and Saraswati— Prayagraj is famous for Sangam, Kalpvas, Kumbh Fair, Akshayavat, Durvasa Ashram, Atri Ashram, Bharadwaj Ashram, Khusrobagh, Sita Samahit Sthal, Lakshagriha, Shringverpur etc.

Prayagraj has been the spiritual citadel from time immemorial. It derived its name by the synthesis of two Sanskrit words - 'Pra' and 'Yag' which means the place of holy Yajnas, amplified by a Sanskrit quote - 'प्रकृष्टम् यजनाम् यत्र सप्रयागा' meaning there by the place where Yajnas have been consistently performed is Prayag. It is also said that Brahma performed his first Yajna in addition to 10 Ashwamedha Yajnas here under the protection of Lord Vishnu. Kumbh Fair having its connection with the fall of the nectar from earthen pot (Kumbha) by mohini image of Lord Vishnu adds special vista to the glory of Sangam and the holy bathing attached to it. Harshvardhan used to come to Prayagraj during Magh fair and donate to the last penny of his savings liberally to the needy people.

The Yajna Bhoomi of Acharya Kumaril Bhatt is situated at Jhansi (Pratishthanpur), neighbouring Maharshi Durvasa Ashram on the bank of holy Ganga. Added to this, not very far off, are the holy places existing in Varanasi, Chitrakootdham, Vindhyachal, Kaushambi, etc.
