



## About The University

**The Foundation of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) was laid in the village Jamunipur Kotwa in the Phulpur parliamentary constituency by late Pt. Jawaharlal Nehru in 1962 with a dream to establish a center of higher learning in rural India. The vision of Pt Nehru has been translated into action through philanthropic leadership and efforts of Shri J. N. Misra leading to establishment of present University which was declared as Deemed to be University in the year 2008. Presently, NGB (DU) has more than 500 teaching, administrative & supportive staff, more than 5000 UG & PG students, along with 400+ research scholars. The University has 6 faculties with 26 Departments ranging from traditional to professional programmes. ## About Course :



Research is a systematic and organized process of investigating, studying, and analysing data to gain new knowledge, insights, or solutions to specific questions or problems. It typically involves a structured approach that includes, formulating research problem, data collection, analysis, interpretation, and drawing conclusions, often with the aim of contributing to the existing body of knowledge in a particular field or discipline. A research methodology course in Social Science is essential for building the skills and knowledge required to conduct meaningful and rigorous research, contributing to the advancement of the field and preparing students for diverse career paths. The course aims to impart skills that will enable young research scholars for nurturing their talent as future researchers. The present course would emphasize interactive sessions, analytical exercises, group discussions, sample collection, tools, techniques, research papers.

Course will be able to attempt the need to build capacity and develop the potential of researchers in social sciences to adopt an interactive, system-theoretic, unified approach in research. The subjects covered must thoroughly explore aspects of the social process which are interlinked, such as, the economic with the political; the political with the cultural; the cultural with the religious and the geographic with the economic and to take a holistic view of the social processes with its application to special empirical problems.



## Main Objectives of the Course

- To acclimate research students to philosophical approaches, such as historical-analytical, legal institutional, descriptive-taxonomic, behavioral, interdisciplinary, decision-making, and so on.
- To develop skills in creating an adequate research plan, which involves conducting a literature review, generating research questions and hypotheses, gathering data, and analyzing it.
- To provide instruction on relevant research methodologies, which include scientific method, empirical method, comparative method, historical method, and deductive method.

- To develop capacity for conceptualizing and writing research proposals, synopsis, thesis, reports, etc.
