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ABOUT THE NGB (DU)

Emerging as the first rural university in the state of Uttar Pradesh, Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) is one of the few higher education institutions in India located in rural area. The Union Ministry of Education (formerly the Ministry of Human Resource Development) recognized it as a "Deemed to be University" in accordance with section 3 of the UGC Act, 1956, as stated in Notification No. F.9-42/2005-43(A), dated June 27, 2008 & No. 12-25/2023-U.3(A) dated 24th November, 2023.

Nehru thought that the development of the hinterland depended particularly on the role that education and social participation played.

Pandit Nehru's dream of having institutions of higher learning in the villages, particularly for rural population was transformed into reality in 2008 by Sri J.N. Misra, a former bureaucrat turned social thinker and philanthropist. It was Sri J.N. Misra's unflinching belief in the ideals of Gandhi and Nehru and his vision and dedication for uplifting the rural masses through quality higher education, that led to the establishment of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj in 2008.

NGB (DU) is located in co-existence with natural environment. As NGB (DU) has already started to amend its program curriculum and make them NEP-2020 compliant from academic session 2023-24. For this, It aims to strengthen the ecosystem that fosters entrepreneurship and research by emphasizing on collaborations and Industry linkages and updating of lab facilities for equipping our students with entrepreneurial education, training and imparting necessary skills at the workplace facilitating connections with mentors, investors, and peers for supporting new startups by empowering individuals to innovate and pursue their business ideas for generating more employment.

About the Founder

Mr. J. N. Misra was born on Oct. 1st 1938 in Allahabad (Now Prayagraj) the land of Hindu Mysticism and philosophy and the world famous 'Kumbh Mela'. Hailing from a remote rural village, he was raised in an environment boastful of immense political upheaval and social transformation. India being enslaved for more than two hundred years under the British colonial regime, had finally found her freedom. But the



world largest democracy found its freedom crippled and to met with many challenges. And hence the nation building process had started and to further accelerate this process there was an aggressive drive to create an awareness and enforce the importance of education among the people especially the rural youth.

It was this political renaissance which fashioned the thought process, a young boy who found his icon in the magnetism of its leaders especially Mahatma Gandhi & Jawahar Lal Nehru. A stand from a very austere start and meager resources, he imparted himself with the finest of knowledge and learning while working to make ends meet to not only support his family but also to fulfill his dreams of doing exceedingly well at his studies, and it was his constant perseverance and hard work which yielded him with fruitful results and from a small rural makeshift shift school with a thatched roof he went to a very Allahabad University, one of the most prestigious University and from there on there was no stopping for his aspirations.

He joined the very esteemed Indian Civil service at the State level in 1963 and further on was promoted and joined the Government of India at Central level in 1973 the Ministry of Shipping, Transport and Railways and it was during this period under the tutelage of late Mr. Kamla Pati Tripathi, a very famous social activist and philanthropist, he went on to achieve much excellence in the field of public service.

Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) formed in 2008-09 after University Grants Commission recommended to the Ministry of Human Resource & Development (Now, Ministry of Education) for granting it Deemed to be University Status. The MHRD notified vide its gazette Notification no. F.9-42/2005-43(A) dated as 27th June 2008 bestowing the Deemed to be University status to Nehru Gram Bharati

The concept of Nehru Gram Bharati was basically conceived by our Ist Prime Minister of India, Late Pt. Jawahar Lal Nehru, who laid the foundation stone of Nehru Gram Bharati on 26th July 1962 in the village of Rishi Durvasha Ashram, Kotwa-Jamunipur, Dubawal Complex of his Phulpur constituency in Allahabad (Now Prayagraj) District.

ADMISSION POLICY

- 1. To ensure admission of students with academic competence and potentialities of high quality so that its alumni may be able to play their role in the process of nation building and social change in a meaningful manner.
- 2. To ensure that adequate number of students from the under-privileged and socially handicapped sections of our society are admitted to the University.
- 3. The Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) NGB (DU), is open to all persons irrespective of gender, caste, creed, religion, race or class, and it shall not be lawful for the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) NGB (DU) to adopt or impose on any person, any test whatsoever of religious belief or profession in order to entitle him/her to be admitted as a student in the NGB (DU) or to graduate there at or to enjoy or exercise any privilege.
- 4. The NGB shall maintain an all-India character and high standards of teaching and research and shall provide merit-based admission in a fair and transparent manner. The merit of a student will be determined through a Common National level entrance examination conducted offline/online by the NGB (DU) either individually or by any other Central/State agency.
- 5. Admission in the Nehru Gram Bharati shall be open to Indian citizens, Non-Resident Indians, and persons of Indian origin. However, the NGB (DU) shall also admit foreign students as per the Government of India and State Government guidelines. Provided that titles, eligibility criteria and duration of Degree programs shall be strictly as per the specifications of degrees prescribed in UGC Regulations. Admissions will be open to NHEQF 4.5, 5.0 & 5.5 Level in NEP-2020 implemented Programmes having multiple entry and exit provisions.

Provided further that equivalence for entry level eligibility shall be decided as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU) for foreign students.

Provided further that no students passing eligibility examination from unrecognized Board or unrecognized University/Deemed to be University shall be allowed admission or grant of degree by the Deemed to be University.

- 6. For NRI/Foreign students, admission shall be made on merit of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations as per provisions of regulatory bodies, as may be applicable.
- 7. There shall be a well established Admission Cell headed by the Director Admissions & accompanied by Coordinators to conduct new/fresh admissions for every academic session as per the admission policy of NGB(DU), Prayagraj.
- 8. Initially student shall be provisionally admitted and after due verification of all relevant eligibility documents with their original documents they shall be finally admitted and thereafter enrolment number for a student shall be generated.
- 9. All the Admissions related documents viz admission forms, transfer /migration certificates, compiled data of admissions etc. shall be preserved in the Admission Cell (in both physical and digital formats) and maintained as per the University norms. The Admission Cell shall provide the information to all concerned departments on a regular basis.
- 10. In cases, where the admissions are to be given by an agency determined by State or Central Government, the Deemed to be University shall follow the norms and procedure as prescribed by them.
- 11. The NGB (DU) wherever necessary, may also consider score/merit in an entrance test conducted by any other State level/ National level agency appointed by the relevant government for admissions. (Eg. CUET UG/PG).

- 12. The admission and enrolment in various program/programs of the various Departments/Faculties of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) including reservation of seats shall be in accordance with the procedure and policy laid down in the ordinance of the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), policies of Government of India, State Government, and UGC norms as applicable to unaided deemed to be universities.
- 13. The number of seats including enhancement or alteration thereof in different programs of various departments/faculties of the NGB(DU) shall be allocated and approved by the Executive Council based on the recommendation of the Academic Council.
- 14. End Semester Examination fees for all programmes shall be applicable as per NGB (DU) norms.
- 15. **Fee Refund Policy :** Request/application of admitted students seeking cancellation of admission and refund of the fee will be entertained as per current UGC Fee Refund Policy.

UNIVERSITY FREESHIPS & SCHOLARSHIPS:

Determination of eligibility norms for Free-ship and Fee Rebates for all students (incl. Sports category): Coverage:

- No. of Seats to be considered is 02% to the total number of seats (separately for UG and PG) for each category.
- Only applicable on Tuition Fee.
- This policy would be applicable for only the general Courses; it will not apply to Professional Courses & the Ph.D. Programme.
- Any student beneficiary, if found eligible, would only be entitled to anyone of the two Freeships OR Fee Rebate/Financial assistance (to be read with Clause B of this document)

(a) Type of Freeships— Merit cum means 75% marks in qualifying examinations. Should belong to the rural areas (as notified) plus Antyodaya Card holder. 100% of the tuition fees waiver

Note: Subject to Review for continuation.

(b) Cases of Wards (of employees) Existing employee (with a regular appointment, NOT applicable for Adhoc/Temporary/Job Work employees) Applicable to only son/daughter, NOT any other relatives. In case the employee has passed away while being in regular employment, with under as wards, such wards would be considered eligible under this category. Freeship of 50% will be admissible.

(c) Siblings

- 02 Siblings studying in NGB(DU) at any given point (in general courses only would be eligible for 50% freeship for the second/or latter of the two siblings.
- In case 03 siblings are studying in the University they would be eligible for a 100% freeship of 01 student (the third/last of the siblings) as mentioned above.

(d) **Sports:** All Sports cases will be dealt by a notified Sports Selection Board (SSB) of the University, with the quorum decision, compulsorily with the endorsement of an external sports person of repute. For Team events: Evidence of being part of the 1st and/or 2nd position holder final playing team is essential.

For individual events: Appropriate Evidence required. Any event sanctioned/supported by IOC/National Federations/State Federations/ Associations/ Para Games Committee/AIU/Khelo India/ etc. Would be considered for the following:

(i) International participation — 100% freeship

(ii) National level Medal/Certificate — Gold/Silver/Bronze and /or 1st /2nd and 3rd place only - 100% Freeship

(iii) State level Medal/Certificate — Gold/Silver and / or 1st /2nd only — 100% Freeship.

Note: In case a candidate is in a Professional Course/PhD Programme then they may make a represent their case to the Competent Authority for consideration.

(e) **Divyangjan:** 50% Freeship for candidates with 40% and above disability/ blindness/ hearing impaired — as certified by the CMO.

(f) Any other categories

(i) Wards of Ex-Servicemen : 50% Freeship with the following conditions only 75% marks in qualifying examinations. Should belong to the rural areas (as notified).

(ii) Members of any special Community residing in the 50 km radius of the University: 50% Freeship — Evidenced by the certificate from the DM.

(iii) Wards of Alumni— 50% Freeship

(iv) Candidates having lost both parents during Covid 19 Pandemic — 50% Freeship (on certification from the DM)

- (v) Third Gender 50% Freeship evidence with a cerficate from Competent Authority.
- (vi) Candidates from the North East of India, & UTs: 50% Freeship.

- **A.** Fee rebate/financial assistance of any kind would be admissible only on the following conditions:
 - Can only be granted by the Chancellor, Vice Chancellor, Pro-Vice Chancellor and/or on the recommendations of the Executive Council, only on special cases.
 - Would be applicable only once, on sanction.
- **B.** Procedure for the same.
 - All the above cases would be routed through the office of the Dean (Student Welfare) to the Competent Authority.
 - Fee Payment methods: Online and Offline both.
