Course will be able to attempt the need to build capacity and develop the potential of researchers in social sciences to adopt an interactive, system- theoretic, unified approach in research. The subjects covered must thoroughly explore aspects of the social process which are interlinked, such as, the economic with the political; the political with the cultural; the cultural with the religious and the geographic with the economic and to take a holistic view of the social processes with its application to special empirical problems.



RESEARCH METHODOLOGY COURSE

The five-day Research Methodology course, by the Department of Sociology of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), Prayagraj and the Indian Council of Social Science Research, was held from 20 November 2023 to 24 November 2023 in the auditorium of the Research Center located at Shashi Campus of Nehru Gram Bharati Deemed University Prayagraj.

The vote of thanks in the inaugural session was given by the Registrar of the University, Shri RL Vishwakarma.




