# About Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University)

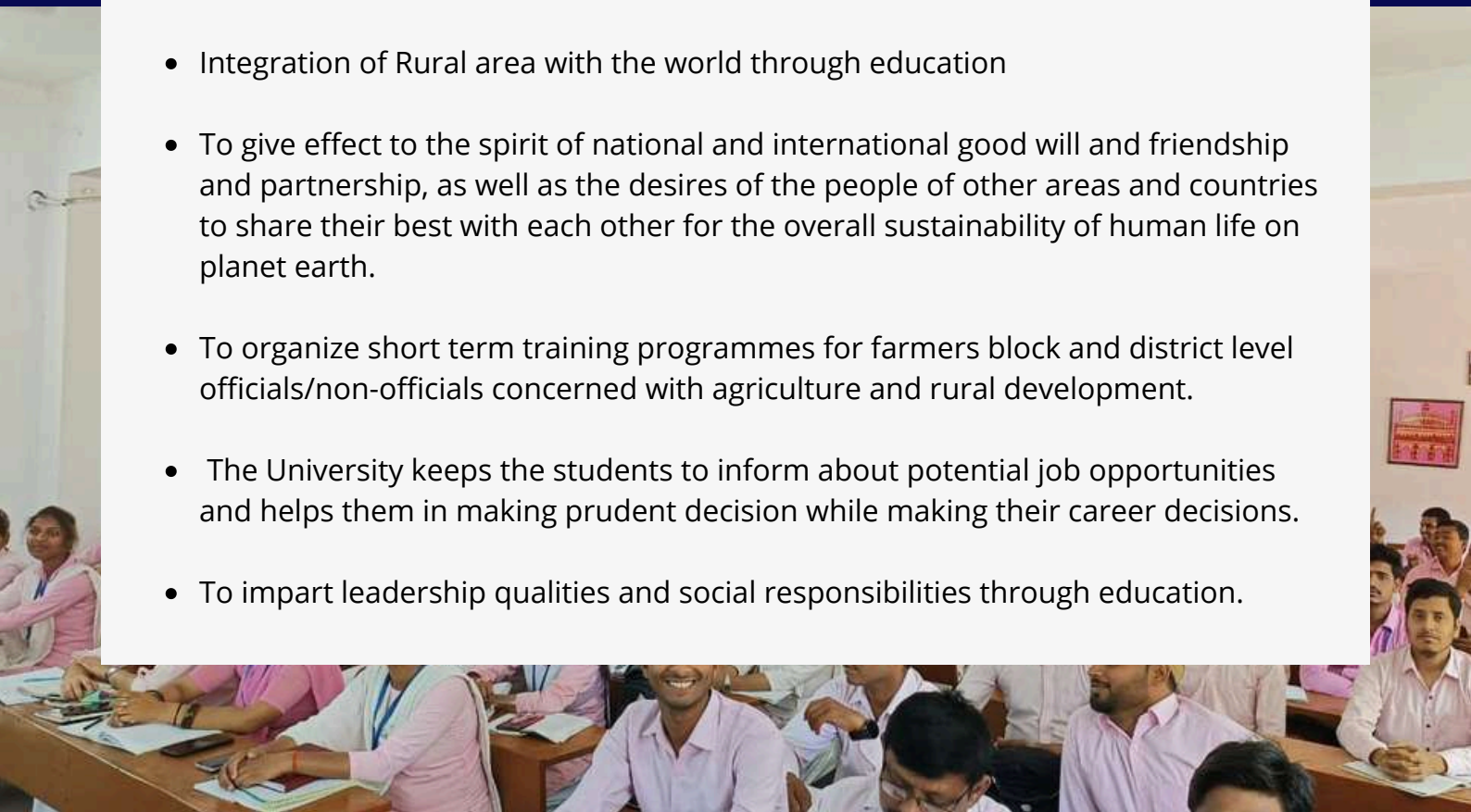
## Our Mission:

# ADMISSION POLICY



# GENERAL CONDITIONS

1. The Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) (NGB(DU)), is open to all persons irrespective of gender caste, creed, religion, race or class, and it shall not be lawful for the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) to adopt or impose on any person, any test whatsoever of religious belief or profession in order to entitle him/her to be admitted as a student in the NGB(DU) or to graduate there at or to enjoy or exercise any privilege
2. The NGB shall maintain an all-India character and high standards of teaching and research and shall provide merit-based admission in a fair and transparent manner. The merit of a student will be determined through a common national level entrance examination conducted offline/online by the NGB(DU) either individually or jointly with other
3. Admission in the Nehru Gram Bharati shall be open to Indian citizens, Non-Resident Indians, and persons of Indian origin. However, the NGB(DU) shall also admit foreign students as per the Government of India and State Government guidelines. Provided that titles, eligibility criteria and duration of Degree programs shall be strictly as per the specifications of degrees prescribed in UGC Regulations. Provided further that lateral entry shall be allowed only as per the provisions of regulations of regulatory bodies, as may be applicable to a program. Provided further that equivalence for entry level eligibility shall be decided as per Association of Indian Universities (AIU) for foreign students. Provided further that no students passing eligibility examination from unrecognized Board or unrecognized University/Deemed to be University shall be allowed admission or grant of degree by the Deemed to be University.
4. For NRI/Foreign students, admission shall be made on merit of marks obtained in the qualifying examinations as per provisions of regulatory bodies, as may be applicable.
5. There shall be a well established Admission Cell headed by the Admissions Coordinator, Admissions to conduct new/fresh admissions for every academic session as per the admission policy of NGB(DU), Prayagraj.
6. The Admissions Coordinator shall initiate all admission procedure in coordination with The Registrar and other related functionaries of NGB(DU).
7. All the Admissions related documents viz admission forms, transfer certificates, migration certificates, compiled data of admissions etc. shall be preserved in the Admission Cell ( in both physical and digital summary formats) and maintained as per the University norms. The Admission Cell shall provide the information to other related departments as and when required in the form requested.
8. The enrollment number for a student shall be generated automatically on the system while filling/submitted Admission Form after depositing the Admission Fee.
9. Where admissions are to be given by an agency determined by State or Central Government, the Deemed to be University shall follow the norms and procedure prescribed for such admissions.
10. The NGB(DU) where necessary, may also consider score/merit in Entrance Tests conducted by any other State level/ National level agency appointed by the relevant government for admissions (. Eg. CUET UG/PG)

# ADMISSION NORMS

1. The admission and enrollment in various programs of the various Department/Faculties of Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) including reservation of seats shall be in accordance with the procedure and policy laid down in the Ordinance of the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University), policies of Government of India, State Government, and UGC norms as applicable to unaided deemed to be universities.
2. Admissions to various programs of the NGB(DU) shall be made strictly on the basis of CUET/NGB(DU) Entrance Test/Interview and Group Discussion.
3. Merit for admission to various programs of the NGB(DU) may be determined either on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the CUET/ other applicable entrance/qualifying examinations along with applicable considerations as approved by competent authorities/regulatory/statutory bodies and NGB(DU) Ordinance, achievements in co- curricular and extra- curricular activities or on the basis of marks or grade obtained in the entrance test conducted offline/online at the National level either by NGB(DU) or an association of the Universities offering similar programs, or any other agency assigned such responsibility.
4. The number of seats including enhancement or alternation thereof in different programs of various Departments/Faculties of the NGB(DU) shall be fixed by the Executive Council on the recommendation of the Academic Council.
5. The NGB(DU) will adhere to the criteria of reservations in admission as per the policy of the Government of India, State Government, UGC guidelines related to unaided deemed to be universities.
6. Number of seats in the Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University)  
The Executive Council on the recommendation of the Academic Council has fixed the number of seats in various programs of the NGB(DU) at the beginning of each academic session in accordance with availability of teachers and infrastructure and as per permission received from regulatory bodies. It may be revised, if required, with due approval as mentioned above.

## Alteration of seats in different programs:

The Academic Council may propose the alternation of seats in different programs to the Board of Management through the Vice Chancellor.

1. The Vice-Chancellor shall recommend the alternation of seats to the Board of Management stating reasons for such alternation.
2. The Executive Council may approve the alternation as proposed by the Academic Council and recommended by the Vice-Chancellor.
3. Provided that such alternation shall not be made for those programs for which specific number of seats is permitted by regulatory bodies.

Admissions are made on "The basis of merit", followed by direct Interview by an admission committee.

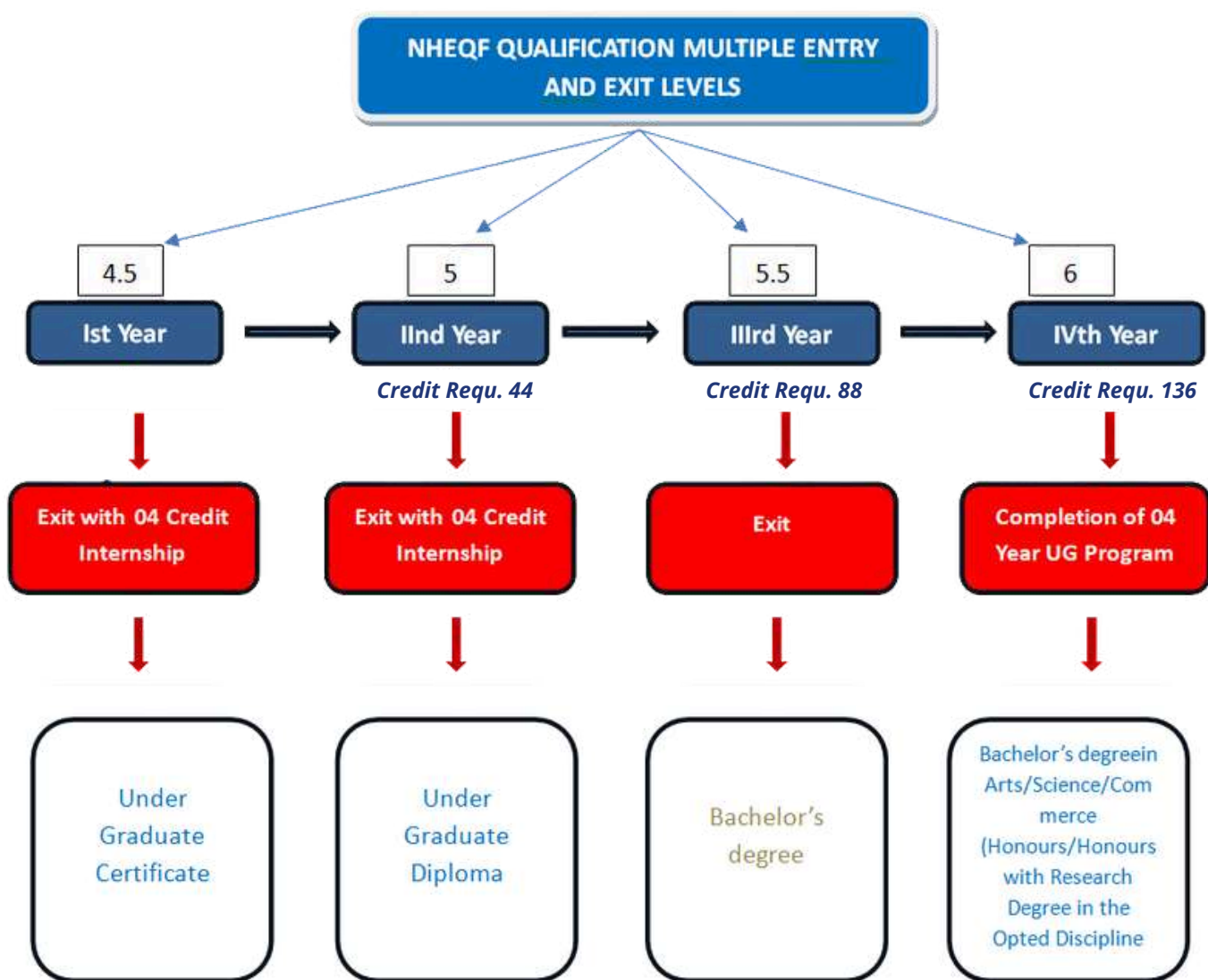

### UP and NSP Scholarships Opportunities:

# University Free Ships:

A. Determination of eligibility norms for Free-ship and Fee Rebates for all students (incl. Sports category):

## Coverage:

- No. of Seats to be considered is 02% to the total number of seats (separately for UG and PG) for each categories. Only applicable on Tuition Fee.
- This policy would be applicable for only the general Courses; it will not apply to Professional Courses & the PhD Programme.

Any student beneficiary, if found eligible, would only be entitled to anyone of the two – Freship OR Fee Rebate/Financial assistance (to be read with Clause B of this document)

## a) Type of Freeship –

Merit cum means

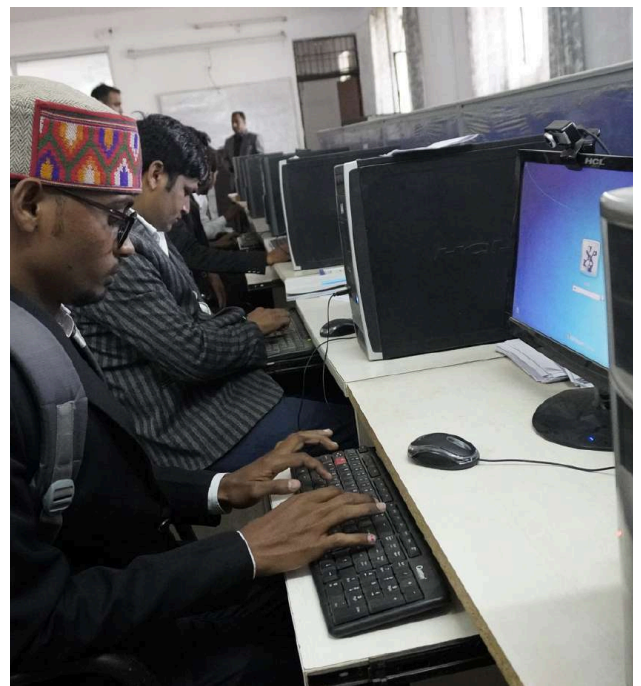
- 75% marks in qualifying examinations.
- Should belong to the rural areas (as notified) plus Antyodaya Card holder.
- 100% of the tuition fees waiver

Note: Subject to Review for continuation.

## b) Cases of Wards (of Employees)

- Existing employee (with a regular appointment, NOT applicable for Ad Hoc/Temporary/Job Wark employees)
- Applicable to only son/daughter, NOT any other relatives.
- In case the employee has passed away while being in regular employment, with under as wards, such wards would be considered eligible under this category.

- Freeship of 50% will be admissible.



## c) Siblings:

·02 Siblings studying in NGB(DU) at any given point (in general courses only would be eligible for 50% freeship for the second/or latter of the two siblings).

·In case 03 siblings are studying in th University they would be eligible for a 100% freeship of 01 student (the third/last of the siblings) as mentioned above.





#### **(d) Sports:**

All Sports cases will be dealt by a notified Sports Selection Board (SSB) of the University, with the quorum decision, compulsorily with the endorsement of an external sports person of repute.

For Team events: Evidence of being part of the 1st and/or 2nd position holder final playing team is essential.

For individual events: Appropriate Evidence required. Any event sanctioned/supported by IOC/National Federations/State Federations/Associations/ Para Games Committee/AIU/Khelo India/ etc. Would be considered for the following:

(i) International participation – 100% freeship

(ii) National level Medal/Certificate – Gold/Silver/Bronze and /or 1st /2nd and 3rd place only -100% Freeship

Note: In case a candidate is in a Professional Course/PhD Programme then they may make a represent their case to the Competent Authority for consideration.

**(e) Divyangjan:** 50% Freeship for candidates with 40% and above disability/ blindness/ hearing impaired – as certified by the CMO.

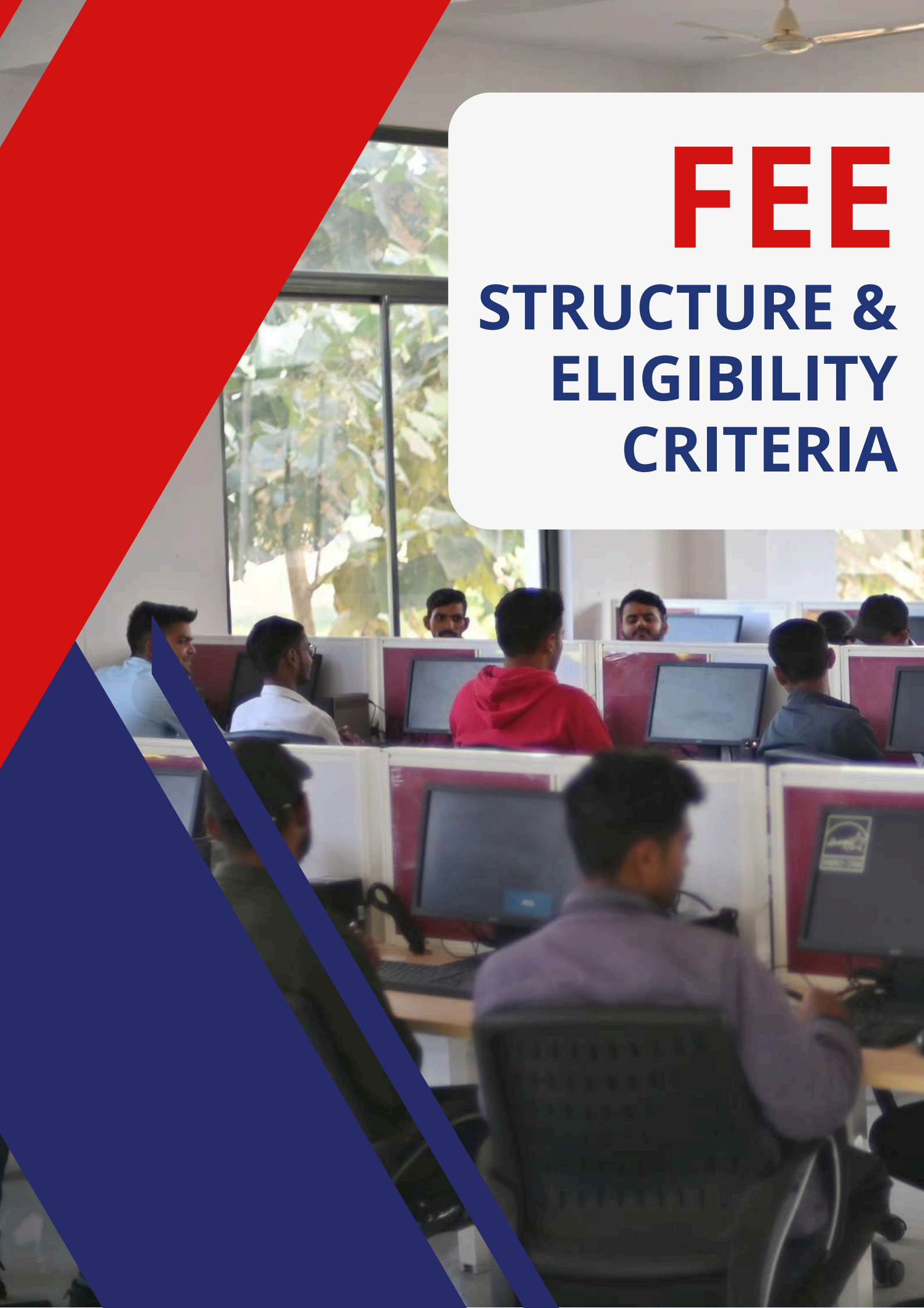



# CAMPUS FACILITIES

## Infrastructure facilities (Classrooms, Laboratories & Libraries)

NGB(DU) has adequate spacious classrooms/tutorial rooms with necessary lighting and ventilation. Out of these, Most of the classrooms are ICT enabled and are equipped with LCD projectors, Interactive Panels and can be connected with desktop systems/laptops and the internet, so that the faculty members can enrich pedagogy with various e-resources accessible through the library and internet, and practice a blended learning approach. In addition, Big Conference Halls and Small Conference/Meeting rooms, auditoriums and seminar halls equipped with lecture capturing systems are available to support various academic activities.

The e-content development facility is available at Media Lab/Studio is fully equipped to produce audio/video course materials for the students of NGB(DU). NGB(DU) YouTube Channel has a repository of curriculum based audio-visual programmes of various streams like Sciences, Social Sciences, Education, Commerce, Arts, Management & Computer Application etc. Other initiatives regarding updation in the Teaching learning Facilities include launch of Institutional Learning Management System (LMS).

NGB(DU) has 29 well-equipped laboratories spread among its campuses for teaching and learning. Department of Teacher Education has Education Technology/ICT Lab, Digital Language Skill Lab, Psychology Lab, Arts & Crafts Lab, Social Lab. The Department of Special Education has 01 Audiology Lab, 01 Speech Language Pathology Lab, Ear Mould Lab, Psychology Lab. The Department of Computer Application has 02 Labs (i.e. Computer Lab and Digital Lab) and the Department of Mass Communication and Journalism has Media Lab/Studio. The Faculty of Science has Laboratories for its UG and PG Students separately. The Department of Zoology has established Soil & Water Testing Lab. The Department of Geography and Home Science have one Lab each.

To facilitate development of an entrepreneurial ecosystem in the organization, Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) has established Institutional Innovation Council (IIC).

The Research Centre has Central Instrumentation Facility, where, the sophisticated equipments and instruments required for quality research are installed and can be used by the Students and Research Scholars of various Departments. The NGB(DU) has established a well equipped Incubation Centre for promotion of startups.

### Central Library:

A New multistoried state-of-art building for Central Library having built-up area of 3496.28 Sq.Mts consisting of an e-library (having capacity of 30 Systems) and reading room facility with a seating capacity of 200 students . The building is divyangjans friendly and having provision of ramps, railings and accessible toilets.

NGB(DU) have a fully digitalized automated Central Library, situated in the main campus, having more than 50,000 books covering all major subject areas.The reading room has a large range additions of Newspapers, Magazines, Journals and other important write-ups which serve students in a purposeful manner. Nehru Gram Bharati (Deemed to be University) uses SOUL 3.0, Which is an Integrated Library Management Software designed and developed by the INFLIBNET Centre.

The users of the library have access to services such as reprographics, print, scanning and more. In addition, the reference section, newspaper & magazine reading section, separate section for faculty members and more are provided. Users of the library have access to digital resources through its 25+ dedicated computers and 1 Gbps internet.The Central Library has been enriched with subscription of quality e-Journals/Journals to enrich quality research. DELNET, a network of digital Libraries has also been subscribed.

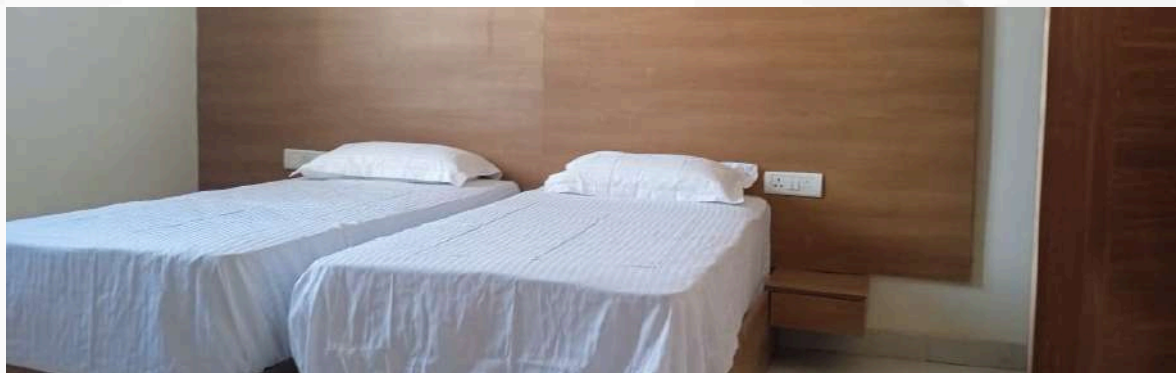

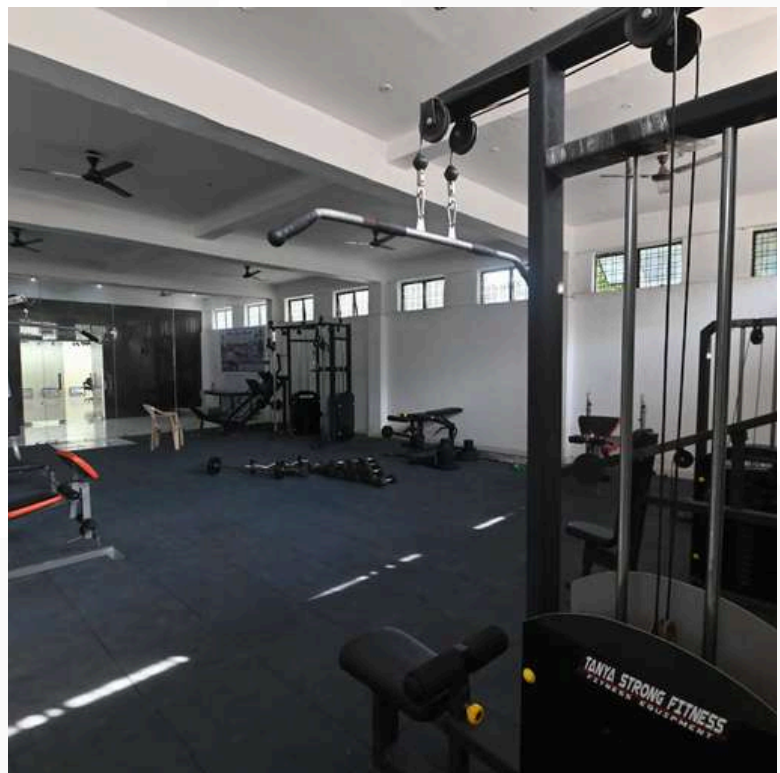
- NGB(DU) has a well-equipped Gymnasium for both Boys and Girls Students.
